District and Circle, Seamus Heaney's twelfth collection since *Death of a Naturalist* (1966), was published in April 2006 by Faber and Faber. There are 44 titles including 5 sequences – 68 poems in all. For *District and Circle*, Seamus Heaney won the T. S. Eliot prize and the Irish Times "Poetry Now Award". After these, and other great accomplishments, Seamus Heaney confirmed his reputation as one of the best Irish poets of all times. A sequence of 5 sonnets bears the title Heaney chose for the collection as a volume, after long consideration of alternatives.
