Modern history, the modern period or the modern era, is the linear, global, historiographical approach to the time frame after post-classical history. The concept of Germany as a distinct region in central Europe can be traced to Roman commander Julius Caesar, who referred to the unconquered area east of the Rhine as Germania, thus distinguishing it from Gaul (France), which he had conquered. German is the official language of Germany (with Danish, Frisian, and Sorbian as minority languages) where it is spoken by 70 million people as a first language and by another 8 million people as a second language. Standard German is the only official language in Liechtenstein and Austria.
