

Download Hamilton Vberetta U S Acorp

The jury returned a special verdict finding that American Arms, Beretta U.S.A. and Taurus International Manufacturing negligently marketed and distributed handguns, proximately causing injuries to plaintiff Fox worth \$3.95 million. The jury also found that the Defendant manufacturers' liability should be based on their respective national market shares. CARDAMONE, Circuit Judge: The present action against numerous handgun manufacturers was instituted by the relatives of several victims of handgun violence to recover damages and, according to an amicus brief, to attempt to halt the injury and death of teenage youths — the victims of armed youthful criminals.
