

# Download Junior High At Age Seventy Five

Phillip will be 90 in June. What a role model for a guy 20 years his junior. Black American missionary to Liberia, Eliza George, was forced by her mission to retire at age 65. Undeterred, she raised her own support and continued independently for the best part of three more decades. BLOOD PRESSURE AND OLD AGE dropped to lower levels with cancer, infections, or heart failure. (These cases either died or became invalids, instead of living a fairly normal life as they had.) Not long after that experience Elder Clark's family moved to Spokane, Washington, where he attended junior high and high school. The firm testimony of a living prophet gained at a young age helped shape the important decisions Elder Clark has made throughout his life—especially in learning to use the Spirit as his guide. Researchers say that old age should be defined as having 15 or fewer years left to live, which for the baby boomers means that they are still middle aged until their 74th year.
