

Download Our Lord's Sermon On The Mount

Our Lord, First, lays down the sum of all true religion in eight particulars, which he explains, and guards against the false glosses of men, to the end of the fifth chapter. Nay, and our Lord forbids to 'cast our pearls before swine.' I answer, (1.) Whether they will finally be lost or saved, you are expressly commanded to feed the hungry, and clothe the naked. Our Lord's Sermon on the Mount is a book by the 4th–5th-century saint Augustine of Hippo. [1] Augustine undertook this work before working on the Pauline Epistles because he considered chapters 5–7 of the Gospel of Matthew (the Sermon on the Mount) "a perfect standard of the Christian life". When you read the sermon on the mount, it seems like Jesus is giving us a lot to say and do. He tells us that our anger is just like murder. He says that our lust is the same as adultery. He reminds us that it would be better to pluck out our eyes or cut off our hands than to go to Hell.
