However, when we look at the population of China alone (Tibetan population included), only 24.10% are age 19 & under while 41.24% are age 29 & under! These differences mean that for both these age groups (19 & under and 29 & under) in China - the population of Tibetans is greater by ~46% and ~33% respectively. These numbers are shown in the table below.
