It's an experiment in close-reading in which seven women are reading the book and conducting a conversation in the margins. The Golden Notebook is a 1962 novel by Doris Lessing. It, like the two books that followed it, enters the realm of what Margaret Drabble in The Oxford Companion to English Literature called Lessing's "inner space fiction"; her work that explores mental and societal breakdown. Doris Lessing was born Doris May Tayler in Persia (now Iran) on October 22, 1919. Both of her parents were British: her father, who had been crippled in World War I, was a clerk in the Imperial Bank of Persia; her mother had been a nurse. Doris May Lessing, nata Tayler (Kermanshah, 22 ottobre 1919 – Londra, 17 novembre 2013), è stata una scrittrice britannica. Ha vinto il premio Nobel per la letteratura 2007 con la seguente motivazione: «cantrice dell'esperienza femminile che con scetticismo, passione e potere visionario ha messo sotto esame una civiltà divisa».
