When teaching thinking skills in the early years, practitioners should consider the extent to which:

- their questions can focus specifically on stimulating children's thinking (see The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) sets standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old. All schools and Ofsted-registered early years providers must follow the EYFS, including childminders, preschools, nurseries and school reception classes.
