Thomas Middleton (baptised 18 April 1580 – July 1627; also spelled Midleton) was an English Jacobean playwright and poet. Middleton stands with John Fletcher and Ben Jonson among the most successful and prolific of the playwrights at work during the Jacobean period. NOTES. The Revenger's Tragedy was first printed in quarto without attribution by George Eld; some copies are dated 1607, some 1608 (the only variation on the title page), and this is one of a number of stop press variations, i.e., corrections made during printing.
